It's also important to realise that bullying doesn't just happen amongst children, it can happen between two adults and also between an adult and a child. I believe it's something that needs to be openly talked about because our children are going to encounter it, either personally or through observing it, in a variety of places throughout their lives and they need to know how to deal with it in a God-honouring way. We'll share what we have learnt with parents once we've completed the unit but I would encourage you to ask your Year 4-8 child what we've talked about each week. The sessions will be every Thursday afternoon until the end of the term.
