



# Timaru Christian School Procedures

## **O2 - Uniform/Dress**

All students must adhere to the school dress code. It is an important part of developing pride, loyalty, and an identity within the school, and so we require all students to wear the school uniform correctly at all times.

The school holds parents responsible for supplying their children with the correct school uniform and for keeping it clean and in good condition.

All items of clothing should be clearly labelled.

### **Year 1-8 Girls' Uniform:**

- Year 1-6 - white polo shirt (short-sleeve in Summer, long-sleeve in Winter)
- Year 1-6 - school pinafore or skirt
- Year 1-6 – green school jersey
- Year 7-8 – school skirt
- Year 7-8 – navy blue school cardigan (phased in over 2018)
- Year 7-8 – white blouse (short-sleeve in summer, long-sleeve in winter; phased in over 2018)
- Socks (white ankle socks in summer, knee-high navy socks in winter)
- Black shoes
- Green sports top (Year 5-8)
- Blue sports shorts (Year 5-8)
- Navy bucket sunhat
- Students may bring a jacket to school to wear outside in the winter months. They must have a school jersey underneath. (It is not a substitute for the jersey.)

(All items available through Schooltex/The Warehouse except Year 1-6 pinafore which is available at school.)

### **Year 9-10 Girls' Uniform:**

- White blouse (short-sleeve in summer, long sleeve in winter)
- Girls' skirt (as per Year 7-8)
- Socks (white ankle socks in summer, knee-high navy socks in winter)
- Navy school cardigan
- School tie (winter)
- Black shoes
- School Jacket
- Green sports top
- Blue sports shorts
- Navy bucket sunhat

(All items available through Schooltex/The Warehouse except school tie and jacket which are available at school.)

### **Year 1-8 Boys' Uniform:**

- Navy blue mid-length shorts
- Year 1-6 - TCS polo shirt (short-sleeve in summer, long-sleeve in winter)
- Year 1-6 - Green School jersey
- Year 7-8 – white shirt (short-sleeve in summer, long-sleeve in winter; phased in over 2018)

## **Year 9-10 Boys' Uniform:**

- White shirt (short-sleeve in summer, long-sleeve in winter)
- Tab Navy Shorts
- Navy school jersey
- School tie (Winter)
- TCS school socks
- Black shoes
- School jacket
- Green sports top
- Blue sports shorts
- Navy bucket sunhat

(All items available through Schooltex/The Warehouse except school tie, TCS school socks and jacket which are available at school.)

- Swimwear must be modest in design.
- No make-up may be worn by any student. Girls may wear studs or small sleepers in their lower ears, no more than one per ear lobe. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or studs. No other body-piercing is acceptable.
- Students may wear a wristwatch but wrist bands or bangles are not permitted. Necklaces or pendants are also not permitted.
- No outrageous or unusual hairstyles are permitted.  
Colour: Natural colour hair (no bright colours).  
Length: Students' hair is to be kept tidy and off the face, with long hair (shoulder length or longer) held or tied back using appropriate ties or headbands (black, brown, navy blue or dark green). Hair must not be shaved below a number 2 in length.  
Condition: Hair must be kept clean and tidy at all times.  
Design: Extreme hairstyles including, but not restricted to a mohawk, afro, dreadlocks, shaved patterns are not permitted.  
Facial Hair: This should be kept neat and trimmed.

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Shoes must be black leather or imitation leather. No other colours should be on the shoes (including labels, the sole and shoelaces). Shoes should not go above the ankle (i.e. ankle and full-length boots are not permitted).

Students may wear sandals in Terms 1 and 4 but they must also be black leather or imitation leather and below the ankle.
