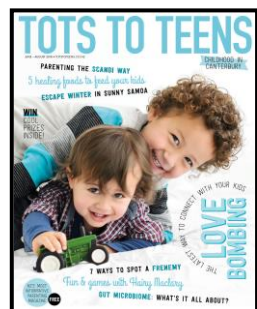
Rural Schools Movie Night
